The Gulf of St. Tropez's layered schist soils influence the typicity of the wines from Château de Chausse.

LOCATION

Coastal area, La Croix Valmer
Saint-Tropez Penninsula, Var, France.

TERROIR

Clay-schist soils

VITICULTURE & VINIFICATION

Vineyards are cultivated according to sustainable agriculture methods. Grapes are hand-picked and hand-sorted then transferred into tank by gravity flow. Long maceration at warm temperatures is followed by fermentation in stainless steel thermo-regulated tanks. Aged for 18 months in French oak.

VARIETIES BREAKDOWN

90 % Syrah
10 % Cabernet Sauvignon

ANALYSIS

ABV: 14.5 %
Acidity: 3.2 g/l
Residual Sugar: 0 g/l

WINEMAKER NOTES

Ruby-red color with garnet tints with rich black fruit and mocha notes. An elegant wine that is both fleshy and silky on the palate. This wine will age gracefully for 5 to 10 years.
