The Gulf of St. Tropez's layered schist soils influence the typicity of the wines from Château de Chausse.

LOCATION

Coastal area, La Croix Valmer
Saint-Tropez Penninsula, Var, France.

TERROIR

Clay-schist soils

VITICULTURE & VINIFICATION

Vineyards are cultivated according to sustainable agriculture methods. Grapes are hand-picked, hand-sorted, and transferred by gravity into the press for a short maceration period before pressing. After pressing, the must is fermented in stainless steel thermo-regulated tanks.

VARIETIES BREAKDOWN

100% Rolle (Vermentino)

ANALYSIS

ABV: 14 %

Acidity: 3.8 g/l

Residual Sugar: 3 g/l

WINEMAKER NOTES

Pale yellow color with silver tints. Deep-rooting Rolle brings an intense aromatic complexity to the wine, with notes of peaches and other yellow fruits. On the palate, the wine is elegant and minerally, with a lingering finish of ripe apricots.
